

## An Index to B. F. Skinner's *Particulars of My Life*

Skinner's three-part autobiography is now complete: *Particulars of My Life* (Alfred A. Knopf, New York, 1976) describes his life from birth until his entrance into graduate school at Harvard in 1928. *The Shaping of a Behaviorist* (Knopf, 1979) continues the story with an account of his years at Harvard, first as a student and then as a research fellow, and his subsequent years as a faculty member at the University of Minnesota and then Indiana University. It closes with his return to Harvard as a full professor in 1948. The final volume, *A Matter of Consequences* (Knopf, 1983), covers the years from 1948 to 1983 and includes a brief epilogue in which Skinner comments on the autobiography as a whole and makes some revealing and fairly general statements about himself.

The first two volumes have no index, and the third has only a brief index. We offer the following to make the autobiography more useful for scholarly purposes. It applies to both the hardcover and paperback editions. Indices for *The Shaping of a Behaviorist* and *A Matter of Consequences* will be published in future issues of this journal.
